Dress Code Policy

The Susquehanna Valley Country Club dress code applies to all Members, their guests and children. It is the individual Member's responsibility to insure that family members and guests adhere to these policies so that all Members may enjoy the Club atmosphere. Management and House Staff are expected to consistently enforce the dress code in a professional and discreet manner.

Clubhouse Dress Code

- ✓ Casual and business attire is permitted in all areas of the Clubhouse. Sport coat and ties are optional. Casual attire includes golf and tennis attire, denim, slacks and pants with appropriate shirts and blouses (no T-shirts), dresses and skirts.
- ✓ Denim must be properly fitted and in good condition.
- ✓ Men must remove hats, visors or caps after 5 pm, except in the TV room.
- ✓ Swimwear with a suitable cover-up may be worn in the Clubhouse before 5 pm and on the outside patio.
- ✓ The dress code for specific events may dictate no denim.

Golf Course Dress Code

- ✓ All men's golf shirts must have a collar or mock collar. Only proper golf pants or shorts are allowed
- ✓ Ladies' golf shirts without collars must have sleeves. Tank or halter tops are not permitted.
- ✓ Denim, T-shirts, cut-offs, tank tops, cargo pants or shorts, athletic shorts, sweat clothes and swimwear are not permitted on the golf course, driving range or putting green.
- ✓ Soft spikes are mandatory.

Cell Phone Policy

Cellular phones and PDA's are only permitted on the property on silent or vibrate mode. Calls in approved areas should be discrete and as brief as possible.

Clubhouse

Receiving and making calls are permitted in the Ladies' and Men's Locker Room and the Coat Room. A cell phone may be used in a room in use for a business meeting that is not open to the general membership. Texts and emails may be checked and sent discretely anywhere in the Clubhouse.

Golf Course

Cell phones and PDA's are only permitted on the golf course on silent or vibrate mode. Texts and emails may be checked and sent discretely. Cell phone conversations are permitted on the golf course but must not slow down play or cause any distractions to other players.

Swimming Pool

Cell phone conversations are permitted in the Bathhouses or Pool Office. Texts and emails may be checked or sent discretely anywhere in the pool area.
